### **DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCEDURES**

SITC staff will be prepared to receive your camper each morning and load your camper back into your car in the afternoon. Enter Edington Way from Jackson St. on the south side of the property for morning drop off and afternoon pick up. Drivers are asked to remain in their cars during carpool.

Morning Carpool: 8:00 a.m. – 8:45 a.m.  
Afternoon Carpool: 5:15 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Each family will be issued a SITC parking flyer to be displayed in the driver's side front window. If someone other than the parent/authorized adult is picking up the camper, please notify SITC, 407-843-6611, in advance of the pick up. Photo ID is required.

### **LATE FEE**

Camp ends promptly at 6:00 p.m. daily. *There will be a charge of \$10 for each quarter hour, or any portion thereof, for each camper picked up after 6:00 p.m.* Parents will be expected to pay upon picking up their camper(s). Campers who are repeatedly late may be dismissed from the program.

### **LATE ARRIVAL OR EARLY DEPARTURE**

In the event your camper will arrive late or be picked up early, please park in the Jackson/Rosalind Street parking garage or at a street parking meter and check your camper out at the first floor reception desk. We will validate your parking ticket if you choose to park in the Jackson/Rosalind Street garage.

### **SNACKS AND LUNCHES**

SITC will provide an afternoon snack each day. It is recommended that campers pack a morning snack and a water bottle each day. Each camper must provide a daily lunch. Labeling items such as lunch boxes and backpacks/cinch bags with the camper's name is highly encouraged.

### **WHAT TO BRING**

Children should dress appropriately for outdoor activities and play. Closed toed tennis shoes are required, as well as sunscreen and a water bottle. For water play days, campers will need bathing suits, water shoes and a towel. Please label all items! Additional personal items should not be brought to camp. This includes electronic devices and phones.

## **BEHAVIOR POLICY**

Good behavior is a key component to a successful summer camp experience. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and will be managed by the SITC staff. Parents will be contacted if inappropriate behavior continues. Campers may be dismissed from camp for inappropriate behavior and refunds will not be granted.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR EACH CAMP**

### **ODYSSEY: June 9 - 13**

Campers will enjoy morning classes by gifted professionals and afternoon downtown excursions. Campers will travel to Menchie's and the Amway Center. We will leave campus for field trips at 1:00 p.m. each day and return by 4:15 p.m., on a rotating schedule. Parents who wish to pick up before afternoon carpool are encouraged to call our front desk receptionist at 407-843-6611 to check on the status of that day's field trip. Field trips are included in the camp registration. Please do not allow your child to bring money to camp.

You are welcome to pick up your Kinder Express camper at 3:30 p.m. or allow them to stay for the full day. Campers will need to bring a book bag or backpack, rest mat, morning snack, lunch and water bottle.
