Position Title: P.F. Teacher/Coach

Hours: 7:30am - 4:00pm, M-F teaching Physical Education classes and after school sports practices and games as scheduled including some Saturdays.

Direct Report: Reports to Director of Athletics and Student Conduct

General Responsibilities:

10 month position during the calendar school year.

Work with the Director of Athletics and Student Conduct and PE staff to plan an age appropriate and challenging P.E. curriculum grades K-8 in planning and leading after school sports teams.

Planning and leading after school sports teams including setting up for games and/or tournaments, and any other task assigned.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Teach TK-8 Physical Education classes
- Coach a sports team each season
- Supervise boys during the usage of the locker room
- Communicate effectively with parents, colleagues, staff and administration
- Assist with planning and presentation of school assemblies and programs
- Support all aspects of lower and middle school sports teams and activities
- Participate in professional development activities
- Proactively seek out ways to improve Physical Education and coaching at TCS
- Perform lunchroom, PAWS and carpool duties
- Lead Middle School Advisory once a week
- Serve as spiritual role model for students, parents and teachers
- Engage with teachers and parents to cast the vision for spiritual formation
- Other duties as assigned
